

## ICMSA Reorganization meeting

The adopted 2021 \$8,1 million dollar budget includes water rates increase of \$2.00 per thousand gallons for Commercial customers. Residential water customers rate increase of 0.50 cents on usage and sewage customers will incur a flat rate increase of 0.50 cents. Water and Sewage tap fees remains the same. System development debt obligations of \$3,425,755 comprise the bulk of expenses.

In 2020 ICMSA begun construction of a 12.2-million-dollar Pennvest Water Renovation 20 project along Rt 85 and Rt. 119 north corridor. The project includes new construction of a water main lines, storage tank, pressure reducing station and plant upgrades of Plumville and Crooked Creek water treatment plants. Water line will extend through portions of Rayne, Washington East and West Mahoning, Cherryhill Townships and Marion Center Borough. Construction is expected to be complete in the summer /fall of 2021
